You are invited to stop by for coffee/tea to and enjoy your muffin following your quiet time.

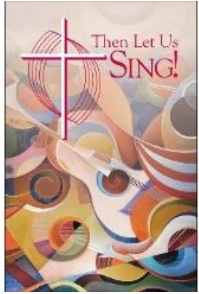
