GIVING WINTER WARMTH UPDATE

Compassion items are always in demand and include shampoo, body wash hand sanitizer, hand lotion, lip balm, toothbrushes, toothpaste, razors, feminine hygiene products, diapers, laundry detergent (consider personal sized).



USED STAMPS: If you have used stamps, you could drop them off in our mailbox or during office hours. Please make sure you leave a tiny margin around the stamp. We are now sending them to the Canadian Bible Society for their Stamps for Freedom Program. Stamps collected from donations across Canada are combined to create charity boxes and are sold to stamp collectors and vendors. The revenue generated from the stamps allows CBS to purchase Bibles for the Canadian prison ministry.
