**USED STAMPS:** If you have used stamps, you could drop them off in our mailbox or during office hours. Please make sure you leave a tiny margin around the stamp. We are now sending them to the Canadian Bible Society for their Stamps for Freedom Program. Stamps collected from donations across Canada are combined to create charity boxes and are sold to stamp collectors and vendors. The revenue generated from the stamps allows CBS to purchase Bibles for the Canadian prison ministry.



**St. David's Trinity United Church** is a designated drop-off for the recycling of household batteries. This includes both rechargeable and single use, each weighing 5 kgs or less. No wet-cell, damaged or defective batteries are accepted.

Batteries can be dropped off at the office between 9:30 and 12:30, Tuesday to Friday.
