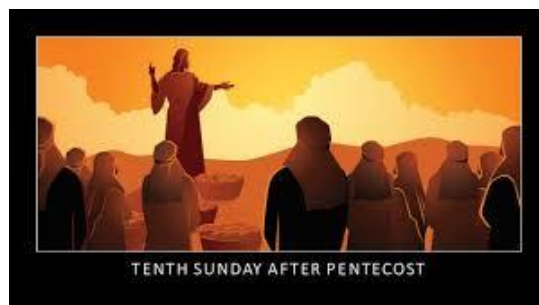

The revenue generated from the stamps allows CBS to purchase Bibles for the Canadian prison ministry.
