Summer Outreach at St. David's Trinity

Friendship Inn (most needed items): Peanut Butter and Jam Coffee and sugar Rice Spices garlic plus, sage, dill, thyme, lemon pepper. Compassion items: Personal size shampoo, body wash and toothpaste, feminine hygiene products, toothbrushes

Core Community Water Initiative: We will also be receiving donations of reusable water bottles and bottled water to be delivered to an agency in core neighbourhood for direct distribution, e.g. Station 20 West or the Friendship Inn.

Saskatoon Community Advocacy & Support (formerly ICM): The Wednesday Chop & Chat lunch program continues through the summer. Volunteers are needed to assist from 11:00-1:00 on Wednesdays. Please contact Susan C., Gwen W. or Anne M. if you're willing to donate a few hours of your time to prepare and serve lunch.

New Outreach Option: The Salvation Army Saskatoon will be delivering essential items to the homeless encampments through to mid-October and are looking for the following items: menstrual products, bottled water, hygiene kits (soap, small bottles of shampoo, toothbrush and toothpaste, socks, underwear). Please label your donation "Hope" if you're supporting this project.



The larger accumulation of items in the Lost and Found has been donated, but we still have 2 pairs of eyeglasses and a water bottle that need to be claimed. The glasses are currently on the table in the church entranceway.



USED STAMPS: If you have used stamps, you could drop them off in our mailbox or during office hours. Please make sure you leave a tiny margin around the stamp. We are now sending them to the Canadian Bible Society for their Stamps for Freedom Program. Stamps collected from donations across Canada are combined to create charity boxes and are sold to stamp collectors and vendors. The revenue generated from the stamps allows CBS to purchase Bibles for the Canadian prison ministry.



St. David's Trinity United Church is a designated drop-off for the recycling of household batteries. This includes both rechargeable and single use, each weighing 5 kgs or less. No wet-cell, damaged or defective batteries are accepted.

Batteries can be dropped off at the office between 9:30 and 12:30, Tuesday to Friday.

Individual storage boxes are now available in the office.
