 The Saskatoon Centre of the Royal Canadian College of Organists will be hosting an international artist performing at **Knox United Church**. Tina Christiansen is an active concert organist in Denmark with an extensive international career as a soloist, chamber musician and accompanist. She has played numerous concerts throughout Denmark as well as more than 90 concerts across Europe and Russia. She has played solo concerts at some of Europe's largest organs including St Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey in London. Tina is the organist and director of music at Ansgar's Church in Odense (DK), and she is the artistic director of the Odense International Organ Festival. Admission is by donation (suggested \$25/adult).
