She has played numerous concerts throughout Denmark as well as more than 90 concerts across Europe and Russia. She has played solo concerts at some of Europe's largest organs including St Paul's Cathedral and Westminster Abbey in London. Tina is the organist and director of music at Ansgar's Church in Odense (DK), and she is the artistic director of the Odense International Organ Festival.
